If you still cannot enter the meeting, click here. On the left navigation bar, click "Support."

**First Time Users:** To save time before the meeting, <u>check your system</u> to make sure it is ready to use an appropriate player required for rich media files. WebEx will automatically set up <u>Meeting Manager</u> for Windows the first time you join a meeting. However, you can set it up prior to the meeting and save time.

**Notice**: WebEx service includes a feature that allows audio and any documents and other materials exchanged or viewed during the session to be recorded.
